Part Two Certification

Common Manufacturing Hazards

Certification training is the law. The 1990 amendments to the Occupational Health and Safety Act require virtually all Ontario workplaces with 20 or more employees to establish joint health and safety committees. At least two committee members, one representing the employer and one representing the workers, must be certified through an approved WSIB Certification program.

Part Two, Manufacturing Sector Common Hazards focuses on significant hazards common to the manufacturing sector. The goal is to assist employees in the manufacturing sector that have completed Basic Certification Part One to complete Part Two Certification. Over 2 days (1 day per week) of in-class training, participants will learn about common manufacturing hazards and how these can be recognized, assessed and controlled. Our course has been developed to include 7 self-standing modules that meet the objectives set by the WSIB for sector-specific common hazard training. The seven modules covered are Machine Safety, Chemical Safety, Ergonomics, Mechanical Material Handling, Manual Materials Handling, Walking and Working Surfaces, and workplace violence.

Day One:

1. Machine Safety
2. Chemical Safety
3. Mechanical Material Handling

Day Two:

1. Ergonomics
2. Manual Material Handling
3. Walking and Working Surfaces
4. Workplace Violence
