



Workplace Inspection

This course will assist those responsible for workplace inspections to Identify existing or potential hazards before losses to personnel, equipment, processes, building and the environment can occur.

Participants will:

- Understand the various legal requirements placed upon workplace parties for maintaining a safe working environment.
- Effectively inspect work areas for unsafe acts and conditions.
- Recognize, evaluate and implement controls that will reduce/eliminate the potential for loss.
- Document and communicate identified “hazards” to management and workers for corrective action purposes.
- Understand the importance of developing and implementing effective critical component checks and routine housekeeping inspections.

Method of Instruction: Brief lectures, interactive presentations, group discussions, group and individual exercises and videos.

Who Should Attend: Anyone who is interested in learning more about the identification and control of hazards. Leadership positions, i.e., Managers, Supervisors and Lead hands, and Joint Health and Safety Committee Members.

Course Length: 6 hours including an on site inspection with the participants
